➢ WHO WE ARE

Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Fall River of Fall River is committed to improving the quality of life for those in need by providing comprehensive social and human services including basic and emergency needs, homelessness, immigration issues, housing and residential services, disabilities, adoption, mental health counseling, elder health services, neighborhood rehabilitation, foreclosure help, citizenship services and much more. CCFR works with persons of all faiths and cultures in the Spirit of God's universal love to advance human dignity and promote social justice, truth, and solidarity in our community.

> HOUSING COUNSELING AGREEMENT

By participating in our homebuyer education program, you are agreeing to receive counseling, education, information and application assistance, including computations, assessments and procurement of services, in connection with your pursuit of (a) a home purchase, (b) qualifying for a mortgage loan or other homebuyer assistance program (c) obtaining better loan terms with your current mortgage loan or (d) preventing a home foreclosure. While you are welcomed and encouraged to do so, you are in no obligation to participate in any of our home lotteries, grant programs, or other services. CCFR is also not obligated to enroll you in any other program as a result of your participation in any homeownership education program. Each CCFR program is administered separately and you should seek application information pertaining to your program of interest.

▶ REAL ESTATE DEVELOPMENTS PROJECTS AND OTHER GRANT PROGRAMS

Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Fall River owns and develops real estate property for the purpose of renting or selling to low-income families in relation to its mission of community development. Participating in CCFR's Homeownership Education and Counseling program does not obligate you to purchase or rent any property owned by CCFR and, CCFR is in no obligation to sell or rent you any of our development properties, provide you with any monetary assistance, or provide you with any additional services. Each service and program outside of the Homeownership Education and Counseling Center is offered independently and has its own application, procurement process and participation guidelines. Participants who reside in CCFR owned rental properties are advised to review their lease agreements and abide by its conditions prior to purchasing property. Violations to any CCFR rental lease agreement will be fully enforced to the extent of law.

HOUSING COUNSELING PROGRAM FEE

- A fee is assessed for enrollment in the <u>homebuyer education seminar</u>: \$40 per individual, \$50 per household. This fee is only applicable to "first-time homebuyer" seminars and is <u>not</u> applicable for any other home education workshops.
- All personal counseling sessions are <u>free of charge</u>.

Whenever possible, CCFR housing program staff will always provide a minimum of 3 options for external services. It is always in your best interest to shop around for services and compare costs, fees, terms, services and reputation to find the best product or service that meets your needs.

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PRIVACY POLICY AND AUTHORIZATION

Personal information, as used in this notice, means information that identifies an individual personally and is not otherwise publicly available information. It includes personal financial information such as credit history from credit reporting agencies, income, employment history, financial assets, bank account information and financial debts. It also includes your social security number and other information that you have provided to us orally or on any applications or forms that you have completed.

Confidentiality and Security

Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Fall River realizes that the concerns you bring to us are highly personal in nature. We assure you that all information shared both orally and in writing will be managed within legal and ethical considerations. We restrict access to personal information about you to those of our employees who need to know that information to provide products and services to you and to help them do their jobs, including making loan decisions, aiding you in obtaining loans from others, and financial counseling. We maintain physical and electronic security procedures to safeguard the confidentiality and integrity of personal information in our possession and to guard against unauthorized access. We use locked files, user authentication and detection software and password-protected protocols to protect your information. Our safeguards comply with federal and state regulations to guard your personal information.

Information We Collect:

We collect personal information to

- support our financial fitness counseling,
- assist in qualification for our affordable home development projects
- perform a mortgage affordability assessment
- assist you in shopping for and obtaining a home mortgage from a lender
- assist you in obtaining better mortgage loan terms

We collect personal information about you from the following sources:

- Information we receive from you orally, on applications or other forms,
- Information we receive from a consumer reporting agency,
- Information we receive from independent third parties authorized by you to provide us with your information.

We keep personal information about you for a period of three years from the time a file is closed.

- The information will be destroyed through procedures that ensure protection of private information.
- Information related to participation of certain subsidized programs of which Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Fall River of Fall River, Inc. has a direct service agreement may be kept for longer periods as stipulated by said programs.
- Additional disclosures highlighting exceptions will be provided to you when applicable.
