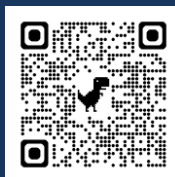
Part 2: In-Person Session: Upon completion of the online course please contact our office to reserve your seat for the in-person session. Limited seats available – secure yours now!"
